

Bringing more working class voters into a progressive coalition requires understanding the particular ways in which different groups of working class voters are cross-pressured.




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
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
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























- The middle and upper classes strongly favored Biden over Trump in 2020, while the working class was split, with high abstention rates.
- By large margins, the working class is to the left of the middle and upper classes on questions of class, distribution, and economic fairness.
- Differences between classes on social and cultural questions are much smaller, and the working class is not uniformly more conservative.





- Across the working class, voters are open to hearing about the accomplishments of the Biden-Harris administration. It is moving votes.
- The most popular parts of VP Harris' bio are her specific accomplishments and plans, more than her identity and personality
- Messages that lean into naming class conflict and naming a villain move all of the cross-pressured segments of the working class in our direction.
